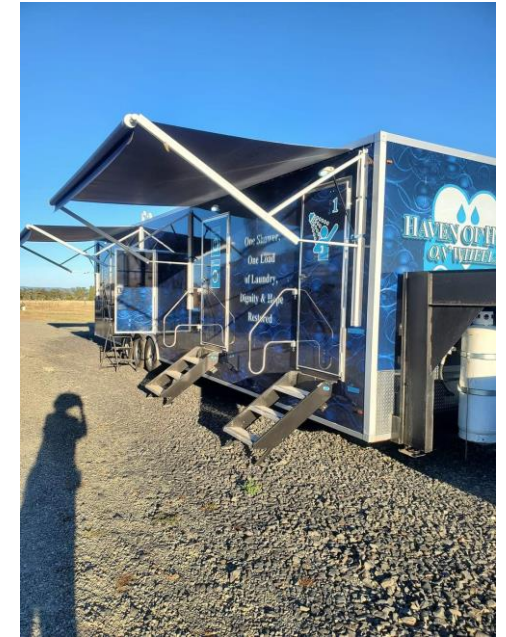

<p>Staff conducted phone banking, text banking, and canvassing to promote two vaccine clinics in June. Superheroes were at the clinics to talk to and distract children who were receiving vaccines.</p>	<p>Provided support at vaccine clinics in the community by distributing COVID-19 educational materials and home testing kits. The partner also provided these resources at their mobile shower and laundry services for vulnerable populations.</p>
<p>The partner reflected that earlier in the year, talking to parents about vaccines for children was challenging. They felt adding different elements and resources to the clinic made it easier to attract families. The clinics vaccinated 283 individuals.</p>	<p>The partner reported most community members they spoke with were open to receiving the vaccine if they hadn't received it already. At the mobile shower and laundry service events, the partner was able to share vaccine clinic information with 111 individuals.</p>
